Packing List

Luggage:

- One medium soft luggage for clothes no exceptions!
 - There is limited space on the tool truck and in the rooms where you will sleep.
- Stuff bag clearly marked with your name
 - Large enough to hold sleeping bag, pillow, work boots, towel (bath) water bottle, and tools.
 - o Must be labeled with name
 - Do not use garbage bag

Work Clothes:

- o 3 pr. pants/jeans/overalls, etc. We **do not** wear shorts on the work sites.
- o 5 T-shirts and/or work shirts
- Work boots (steel toe not required but recommended, buy now to break them in)
- Work socks (extra pairs suggested)
- o Hat
- Raingear. We will work in the rain unless there is thunder and lightning.

After Work Clothes:

- Shorts, long pants for evening.
- T-shirts, tank tops, hooded sweatshirt.
 - IMPORTANT: Tank top straps must be at least two fingers wide. Shorts must be no shorter than the distance to the end of your thumbs when standing with arms relaxed at your side. If adults feel your clothing is inappropriate you will be asked to change.
- Tennis shoes, sandals (important to have something to wear immediately after work).

Sleeping:

- We will be sleeping in college dorms at Malone (two to a room)
- Bring XL twin-size sheets OR a comfortable sleeping bag, preferably the "stuff" style which requires less room when packed.
- \circ Pillow

Other important items:

- Sunscreen
- o Bug repellent
- Water bottle <u>marked with your name</u>
- Sunglasses
- Toiletry bag to take to the shower
- Shower sandals for shower and for wearing after returning home at the end of the day
- \circ Towel
- o Medications

Personal Tools (be sure to put your name on everything):

- Safety glasses
- Tool belt (inexpensive cloth belt is fine)
- Work gloves
- Tape measure and pencils
- Hammer (if you have one, bring one, if not we have plenty)

Van Bag:

- \$20-\$30 for two meals on the road
- The following are not required but may be nice to have
 - Journal
 - o Bible

Cell Phones and Personal Audio:

- Youth can bring cell phones on G&S and use them during specified times:

 - o During free time right before dinner
 - During free time before bed
